- The center is open Monday, Wednesday, Friday from 7am 4pm and Tuesday, Thursday from 9am 6pm.
- Location: Mills Building, 901 S. Kansas, Ave, Topeka KS 66612.
- Eligibility: All State of Kansas employees, spouses, and their dependents ages 2+ covered by the SEHP will be eligible for services provided by the center.
- Cost: All preventive visits are free regardless of health plan enrollment. Healthcare services will be provided at no cost for Plan A members. Medical visits will require a \$40 fee for those members covered under Plans C, J, N, and Q until deductible is met. Once met, medical visits will be provided at no cost.
